Description

OnCourse Maine, a program of Care & Comfort's Behavioral Health Division, has an immediate opening for a Psychiatric RN. This position provides comprehensive, skilled, psychiatric-nursing services, assistance with rehabilitative needs and preventative care for veterans with severe and persistent mental illness(es). The Psychiatric RN also oversees multiple OnCourse Maine teams in several regions.

Duties and responsibilities include:

- Overseeing, planning, providing and evaluating each Veteran's medical and/or psychiatric nursing care to include: personal care, performing treatments as prescribed in the treatment plan, preparing, dispensing and monitoring the effects of medications prescribed by a physician and ensuring interim/renewal physician orders are obtained as necessary and communicated effectively.
- Completing ADL and physical health assessments. Assisting in developing measurable goals on the treatment plan that are mutually set with the OnCourse Maine team and the Veteran and regular follow-up.
- Documenting nursing interventions and veteran response on progress notes.
- Managing staff including, but not limited to, hiring, performance, training and development.

Candidate Requirements

- Must have successfully graduated from an accredited school of nursing and hold a current license to practice as a Registered Nurse in the State of Maine.
- A minimum of two years' experience in direct service is preferred. At least one-year of experience in the area of psychiatric nursing preferred.
- Hold a CPR certification
- Participates in continuing education annually as required by state, federal and company regulations.
- Prior experience in a behavioral health or decentralized environment is a plus.
- All applicants must have a valid driver's license, current auto liability insurance, and reliable transportation.
- Current military personnel or veterans are encouraged to apply.
